The Scientific Committee reserves the right to select the abstracts relevant to the congress topic and decide on the final form of presentation. All abstracts must contain the title of paper, name(s) of author(s) and organization, contact details of the presenting author (email, telephone, fax) and a maximum 400 words summary text in font Times New Roman, size: 12.

Abstract, curriculum vitae and photo submission deadline: November 1st, 2010



CALL FOR POSTERS

The Congress is open for poster presentation. All delegates willing to attend the event are encouraged to submit their work for poster presentation. Posters will be displayed in a dedicated area and so that all who attends will have an opportunity to see them.

POSTER SUBMISSIONS

Authors are requested to submit a maximum 200 word description of the poster electronically through the online submission interface.

POSTER GUIDELINES

Posters should be:

- ◀ Brief and clearly organized
- ◀ Simple, with an obvious theme and easy to read from 2 to 4 meters away

POSTER DIMENSIONS

All posters must fit into a 90 x 120 cm area. Boards will be provided for displaying posters. Tape and tacks will be provided

POSTER AWARDS

Posters will be reviewed and selected by the Poster Committee. An award for the best poster will be given at the conference.
